Pandemic Prevention Measures in Student Hostels in 2021/22

Everyone follows, the whole community protected

As a large number of students reside together in hostels with shared public facilities, the risk of virus transmission in hostels is considered high. Hence, stricter requirements and arrangements on the pandemic preventive measures will be necessary in order to better protect our residents in student hostels when it is fully open in coming academic year!

Vaccination OR regular COVID-19 tests

1. The University strongly encourages student residents to take COVID-19 vaccination. Students who have taken the vaccination 14 days before the check-in day, i.e. August 22, 2021, shall bring along the original document as proof for check-in.
2. Students who have not been vaccinated against COVID-19 will be required to undergo an entry COVID-19 (RT-PCR) nucleic acid test, and present the negative report, either from the government community testing centres or testing institutions recognised by government (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/List_of_recognised_laboratories RTPCR.pdf), dated within 96 hours before check-in; and take COVID-19 tests (Antigen test also accepted) at least every two weeks afterwards at their own expense. Detail arrangements will be announced.

Access Control for residents and visitors & log system

3. No visitor is allowed in hostels at ALL time. Once found, the hostel place and the future application of the resident(s) and visitor(s) concerned will be forfeited immediately.
4. Residents are required to present their student ID card upon every entry and exit.
5. Residents shall take body temperature measurement at the reception counter before 9:00 pm every day, and report to the attendant for any symptoms.
6. Before taking any trip outside Hong Kong, residents shall inform the Warden in advance. Upon arrival to Hong Kong, residents must fulfill government's quarantine requirements off-campus. Residents are also required to report to the reception counter and complete the Health Declaration Form upon returning to the hostel.

Use of Communal Areas and Shared facilities

7. Residents must wear masks properly at communal areas and keep a safe social distance at all time. Residents should maintain good personal hygiene such as wash hands regularly and thoroughly, avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth, cover the mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing, etc.
8. Communal areas in hostel such as main hall, study room and piano room will be closed or reopen depending on the development of the pandemic situation.
9. Good ventilation shall be ensured at necessary communal areas, including pantries, laundry room and washrooms.
