Pandemic Prevention Measures in Student Hostels in 2021/22

Regular Tests for COVID-19

As a large number of students reside together in hostels with shared public facilities, the risk of virus transmission in hostels is considered high. Hence, stricter requirements and arrangements on the pandemic preventive measures will be necessary in order to better protect our residents in student hostels.

The University strongly encourages student residents to take COVID-19 vaccination. Students who have received their second dose of vaccination 14 days before the check-in day shall bring along the original certificate as proof for check-in (only formal document with name and dates of the vaccination is accepted, screenshot is not accepted).

Students who have not taken the final dose of vaccination 14 days before check-in are required to undergo the following tests in order to check-in and stay in the hostel:

1. Present a negative report of COVID-19 (RT-PCR) nucleic acid test dated 96 hours before check-in, either from the government community testing centres or testing institutions recognised by government (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/List_of_recognised_laboratories_RTPCR.pdf);
2. Regular (at least once every two weeks) COVID-19 tests (antigen test also accepted) afterwards at residents' own expense:
 - A. Residents who cannot present the vaccination report finished 14 days before check-in will be charged together with the hostel fee the cost of INDICAID Rapid Antigen Tests ordered at discounted price via the University, while the supply for discounted product lasts, the cost for each test kit will be \$60, and so \$480 for 8 test kits is required for the first term;
 - B. Starting September 15, 2021, on every other Wednesday to Friday, concerned residents shall pick up the test-kit at hostel counter, run the test at the presence of Resident Tutor at reserved timeslot and designated venue/online meeting, and have the result recorded and signed by the witness to confirm (please refer to the notice at individual hostel for the exact time and venue);
 - C. If the test result is positive, the witness shall inform the Warden and UHS immediately, so to send the concerned resident to A&E for further test and follow up; and contact the respective Government unit for further arrangement;
 - D. Residents who do not finish the required tests accordingly will not be eligible to stay in the hostel and the access right will be cancelled. Residents expelled from hostel due to violation of hostel regulation will not have any hostel fee refund.
